

AD Report Pro Requirements

Version 1.3.0

Supported Environment

- Windows 10, Windows 11, or Windows Server on x64 hardware.
- Active Directory domain connectivity to a domain controller.
- The official installer includes the needed application runtime. No separate .NET runtime install is required.
- No PowerShell module or RSAT feature is required by AD Report Pro.
- RSAT or Active Directory Users and Computers is optional for independent verification.

Directory Access And Permissions

- AD Report Pro is read only.
- Read access is required for the directory objects and attributes included in reports.
- No write access is required for normal reporting.
- LDAP or LDAPS connectivity can be used according to your environment configuration.

Licensing And Connectivity

- A thirty day trial is available on first run.
- A valid ADReportPro or FullSuite license enables the product.
- Runtime license validation is local. Internet access is not required for normal use.
- Installing or replacing a local machine license can require elevated Windows rights.

Storage Summary

- Application settings, saved report definitions, exports, and activity logs are stored under the current user profile.
- Back up saved reports and configuration before upgrades or workstation replacement.

Supported Operations

- Run Active Directory reports without changing directory objects.
- Save report definitions for repeat use.
- Export reports to CSV or XLSX where supported.
- Use filters and selected attributes to focus report output.

Important Limitations

- AD Report Pro does not modify Active Directory.
- Reports are limited by the operator account read permissions and domain connectivity.

- Large directories can require more time to query and export.

Preinstallation Checklist

- Confirm domain connectivity from the reporting workstation.
- Confirm the reporting account can read the target OUs and attributes.
- Confirm export folder write access.
- Confirm license or trial readiness.
