

AD Term Pro Requirements

Version 1.4.0

Supported Environment

- Windows 10, Windows 11, or Windows Server on x64 hardware.
- Active Directory domain connectivity to at least one writable domain controller.
- The official installer includes the needed application runtime. No separate .NET runtime install is required.
- No PowerShell module or RSAT feature is required by AD Term Pro.
- RSAT or Active Directory Users and Computers is recommended only for independent verification.

Directory Access And Permissions

- Read access is required for user lookup, group lookup, OU lookup, preview, and refresh operations.
- Production termination actions affect live Active Directory and require appropriate delegated permissions.
- Disable and Move requires rights to disable the account and move it to the target OU.
- Group cleanup requires rights to update group membership.
- Delete Immediately requires delete rights and should be reserved for approved use cases.
- LDAPS is required before Live changes are allowed.

Licensing And Connectivity

- A thirty day trial is available on first run.
- A valid ADTermPro or FullSuite license enables protected termination actions.
- Runtime license validation is local. Internet access is not required for normal use.
- Installing or replacing a local machine license can require elevated Windows rights.

Storage Summary

- Application settings and activity logs are stored under the current user profile.
- Termination profiles and cleanup profiles should be backed up before upgrades or workstation replacement.

Supported Operations

- Find and review existing Active Directory users before termination.
- Disable accounts, move accounts, clear selected attributes, and remove selected group memberships.
- Delete accounts only when the chosen workflow and delegated rights allow it.
- Preview and confirm termination actions before Live execution.

Important Limitations

- AD Term Pro does not bypass Active Directory permissions, domain policy, or object protection.
- Delete actions are destructive and must be limited to approved operational procedures.
- Live termination requires LDAPS and a valid trial or license state.

Preinstallation Checklist

- Confirm domain connectivity from the admin workstation.
- Confirm LDAPS is available before Live termination.
- Confirm delegated rights for disable, move, group cleanup, and delete actions that will be used.
- Prepare termination profiles and test in a lab before production use.
- Confirm license or trial readiness.
